

## Grid operator issues winter warning

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Constraints on the region's natural gas pipelines could pose a challenge to reliable operations, according to ISO New England, the region's grid operator, which allowed that electricity supplies should be sufficient to meet consumer demand. ISO New England has put into place a winter reliability program that will help protect system reliability. In case of unexpected outages, the ISO's procedures include calling on demand-response resources to reduce their energy use, importing emergency power from neighboring regions, and asking businesses and residents to voluntarily conserve electricity.

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
